



St. Vincent de Paul Charitable Pharmacy (SVdPCP)

Helping our neighbors in need.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul Charitable Pharmacy is a fully licensed pharmacy program operating on a stand-alone basis and providing prescribed medications at no charge to low-income individuals who qualify for the pharmacy's services. The pharmacy stocks low-cost drugs for common conditions such as heart disease, diabetes, infections, and other illnesses. The Prescription Program is designed to provide up to a 30-day supply per prescription refill.

How can this program help me?

If you qualify for SVdPCP, your medications will be provided free of charge to you for an eligibility period: 1 month, 3 months, or 6 months. Upon the end of the eligibility period, information will need to be submitted to renew qualification for the program. Once your medications are available for pick-up, you will have the opportunity to meet with a pharmacist who will provide a thorough review of your medication plan.

Do I qualify for SVdPCP Program?

To receive free medications and services through the program, you must:

- Have a valid prescription from any appropriate healthcare provider
- Must be a Dane County resident
- Have no prescription drug coverage, including Medicare Part D plans
- Meet the household income guidelines: 200% of the federal poverty level or lower. Click [here](#) to calculate your household's percentage and determine if you are eligible.

How do I apply for the program?

To apply to SVdPCP Program:

- Each individual who wishes to participate must fill out an initial form with an intake receptionist first. Then a more detailed application will be completed along with proof of income
- Individuals will be certified Monday through Friday 1:00 PM to 3:30 PM
- Keep a photocopy of your application and your original income documents

If approved, you will be able to pick-up and receive additional services from SVdPCP. You will remain enrolled in the program for up to 6 months. To continue receiving free medications and health services, you must reapply every 6 months. If your healthcare insurance status changes at any time, you may become ineligible to receive services at SVdPCP.

What documents are required for my application?

- Photo ID
- Proof of Dance County Residency (bill, lease, current check stub, or photo ID with address)
- Verification of your income and the income of all members of the household, including any of the following which apply to you:
 - ✓ Two most recent paychecks or pay stub
 - ✓ Unemployment Benefit Statement
 - ✓ Statement of Social Security, SSDI, or SSI income
 - ✓ Income portion of FoodShare Benefit Statement
 - ✓ Statement of Child Support and/or Alimony
 - ✓ Latest tax return
 - ✓ Any other source of income with dollar amount received
- If you have no income, please bring:
 - ✓ Letter from the health agency or case manager of the social service agency that referred you, on agency letterhead, stating that you have no income or health insurance
 - ✓ Letter from anyone who give s you money to pay your bills stating that you have no income or health insurance

After your certification expires, you will need to bring in similar documents to continue receiving SVdPCP services.

What medications are available?

Over 250 medications are available with a valid prescription from SVdPCP. See our list on the SVdP website. Medications are also being added or deleted as the supply changes. If you do not see your medication listed please call the pharmacy at (608) 442-7200 for further guidance.

Please note no controlled or narcotic medications can be filled at SVdPCP. These include:

- Controlled pain medications (hydrocodone/acetaminophen, oxycodone, morphine, tramadol etc.)
- Benzodiazepines (lorazepam, clonazepam, diazepam, etc.)
- Stimulants (methylphenidate, dextroamphetamine, etc.)
- Generally, topical products such as creams and ointments are not available
