The St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Program provides case management support to single adults and their families. The support Angela* receives means she can keep her family together in safe housing.

For nearly four decades Angela has struggled with abuse, abandonment, gang violence, mental health issues, and homelessness. Sadly, her four children have also experienced many of these same challenges. When Angela's landlord declined to renew her lease and issued an eviction notice, she found her way to the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Program. Because of you, she now feels confident taking the next steps in her life. **She hopes her story of overcoming challenging times gives someone in a similar situation hope and inspiration to keep moving forward.**

Over the past year, you have...

- Healed and eased the pain of uninsured adults through the **Charitable Pharmacy**.
- Provided **clothing** to neighbors so they could dress with dignity.
- Given **furniture, household goods, bedding, air beds and cribs** to families to create a home and sleep safe and sound.
- Fed and cared for families with food, household goods, personal-care items and pet food through the **Food Pantry**.
- Prevented families from falling back into homelessness through customized, case management support with the **St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Program**.
- Offered a safe place for people experiencing homelessness to store their valuables long term at **Vinny's Lockers**.
- Grown and harvested produce from **Lacy Garden** for distribution at the pantry.
- Alieved immediate worries through **customized assistance** of rent, utility and fuel help.

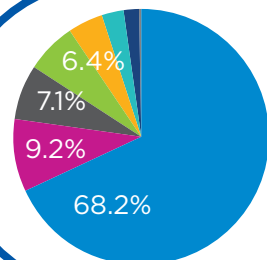
